B	A vehicle with two wheels, pedals connected to the rear wheel by a chain, handlebars for steering, and a seat like a saddle.	BIKE
C	A performer, esp. in a circus, who wears a funny costume and makeup, and acts to make people laugh.	CLOWN
D	Any of various plant- or flesh-eating reptiles of prehistoric times, most of which had long tails and were very large.	DINOSAUR
E	A very large five-toed mammal having a long trunk and large tusks esp. in the males, living in Africa and India.	ELEPHANT
EE	A beverage made from hot water poured over the roasted ground or crushed seeds of the fruit of certain coffee trees.	COFFEE
F	The blossom of a plant; bloom.	FLOWER
G	A stringed musical instrument with a long neck; a flat, somewhat violinlike body; and usually six strings.	GUITAR
H	A heavier-than-air craft that is lifted and kept in the air horizontally by rotating blades attached to its top.	HELICOPTER
I	A frozen mixture eaten as a dessert, made with cream or milk, sugar, and flavoring	ICE - CREAM
J	A stinging, jellylike sea creature.	JELLYFISH
K	A plant-eating animal of Australia and nearby islands, that jumps with powerful hind legs, and carries its young in its pouch.	KANGAROO
L	A small, round, often brightly colored and spotted beetle feeding chiefly on small insects and also on plants.	LADYBIRD
M	Any animal or human that is different from a normal shape or character; any creature ugly enough to frighten people	MONSTER
N	The part of the face above the mouth that contains the nostrils and organs of smell and through which a person breathes.	NOSE
O	A sea creature having a soft, oval body and eight tentacles with suckers on them.	OCTOPUS
OO	An object used in eating, stirring, measuring, etc., made up of a small, shallow bowl with a handle	SPOON
P	A member of a police force or body.	POLICEMAN
Q	A female ruler or monarch. The wife of a king.	QUEEN
R	A large-eared, hopping animal, usually smaller than the hare, living in holes in the ground.	RABBIT
S	The fleshy red fruit of a stemless plant belonging to the rose family.	STRAWBERRY
SH	A hard outer covering of an animal, such as of a clam, snail, or turtle.	SHELL
T	A lightweight, pullover shirt with short sleeves and a collarless round neckline.	T - SHIRT
U	A light, circular cover for protection from rain, snow, or sometimes hot sun, made of a frame of fabric supported by thin ribs that come out of the top of a carrying stick or handle.	UMBRELLA
V	A mountain or hill, usually having a cuplike crater at the top	VOLCANO
W	An odorless, tasteless liquid compound of hydrogen and oxygen that makes up rain, oceans, lakes, and rivers.	WATER

Z	A horselike African mammal having a special pattern of black or dark brown stripes on a whitish background.	ZEBRA

B	A large, stocky mammal with thick, rough fur and a very short tail.	BEAR
C	A close-fitting covering for the head, usually having no brim.	CAP
D	A small figure representing a baby or other human being, used esp. as a child's toy.	DOLL
E	The organ of sight.	EYE
EE	One of the hard bony parts attached in a row to each jaw, serving to bite and chew food or, esp. in animals, as weapons.	TEETH
F	A show where people wears nice clothes and walk to show them.	FASHION SHOW
G	The disembodied soul of a dead person, imagined as nearly transparent and wandering among the living to haunt them.	GHOST
H	The part at the end of the arm in humans, or in other animals, that consists of the wrist, knuckles, fingers, and thumb.	HAND
I	A dome-shaped Eskimo dwelling of blocks of hard snow.	IGLOO
J	The natural fluid or liquid that can be taken, squeezed, or removed from a plant or one of its parts, esp. a fruit.	JUICE

Q	Making little or no noise or sound.	QUIET
R	A bow or arch of colors appearing in the sky opposite the sun and caused by the sun's rays passing through drops of rain.	RAINBOW
S	A scaly reptile with a long thin body that has no arms or legs.	SNAKE
SH	A fish that has a scaleless skin, a wide mouth on the underside of the head, and five to seven gill slits on each side.	SHARK
T	A large, powerful, brownish-orange colored cat with black stripes	TIGER

V	A four-stringed instrument played with a bow and held nearly horizontal by the player's arm with the lower part supported against the collarbone.	VIOLIN
W	A long, soft-bodied, legless creature without a backbone, as the earthworm.	WORM
X	A musical instrument consisting of a series of wooden bars of different sizes, usually played by striking with small wooden hammers.	XYLOPHONE
Y	A spoollike toy that is spun out and reeled in by means of an attached string that loops around the player's finger.	YO-YO
